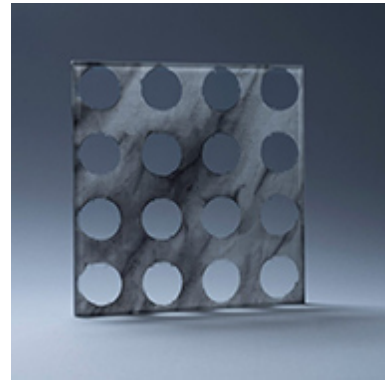

LARGE SEDIMENT HOLE

Round Hole Series



Product Description

Large Sediment Hole combines large-scale circular perforation with manually applied pigment sedimentation. A textile membrane is perforated with twenty-millimeter openings and then dyed with dispersed grey pigments that spread and settle organically across the fabric before lamination. The pigment creates mineral-like tonal variation while the larger perforations allow clearer views and stronger light transmission through the surface. From a distance, the glass appears dense and monolithic, recalling stone or concrete. At closer range, the textile fibers, pigment accumulation, and circular openings reveal a softer and more tactile structure.

Large Sediment Hole creates an architectural surface where perforation, pigment sedimentation, and light interact to produce depth and atmosphere. The result is a material that balances openness with a strong mineral character.

Material & Construction

- Laminated textile glass
- Textile layer: perforated textile manually dyed with dispersed grey pigments
- Chemical perforation with 20 mm circular openings
- Organic pigment sedimentation preserved within the laminate
- Visible textile fibers and pigment variations embedded within the glass
- Double-sided visual depth through pigment and textile structure

Technical Information

- **Thickness options:** 8 / 10 / 12 / 16 mm
- **Maximum panel size:** up to 2000 × 3000 mm
- **Processing:** CNC cutting, edge polishing, custom formats
- **Safety:** laminated; tempered laminated on request

Pigment tone, perforation density, textile type, and panel dimensions can be adapted according to architectural project requirements.
